

CIWW September 2025 Board Meeting Highlights

Central Iowa Water Works is celebrating the completion of its first project as a regionalized entity. The Saylorville Water Treatment Plant West Feeder Main was placed into service September 23, 2025. This main is a key component of the Saylorville Water Treatment Plant Expansion and will provide additional water capacity to the western areas of the metro. The plant's capacity will be doubled from 10 million gallons per day to 20 million gallons per day with the expansion.

At the September board meeting, the Central Iowa Water Works Board of Trustees awarded the next phase of the Saylorville Water Treatment Plant (SWTP) feeder main project, the Hickman Road Feeder Main, to On Track Construction LLC.

CIWW has officially started the planning and design phases of the new West Plant and the Grimes Plant Expansion. The West Plant is anticipated to increase the system's capacity by an additional 12 million gallons per day, while the Grimes Plant Expansion is projected to contribute an estimated 3.3 million gallons per day.

Water Shortage Plan stakeholder meetings will continue through October, with outcomes reports to be drafted and refined in coordination with the board committees during November and December.

The Central Iowa Water Works board meetings are moving to the 3 Fountains Edgewater Building, 4200 University Avenue, Suite 134, West Des Moines, IA 50266 beginning in October 2025.
